

**Guidance for flying into Watts Bridge Memorial Airfield,**  
**26 – 28 August 2016 (Times Local)**

1. The Brisbane Valley Airshow will be held at Watts Bridge Memorial Airfield on Saturday 27 & Sunday 28 August 2016, with a practice day on Friday 26 August.
2. A NOTAM will be issued about the event.
3. All inbound aircraft are to use normal CTAF radio procedures on 127.3 MHz.
4. A reminder that all circuits at Watts Bridge are left-hand.
5. A “WATTS UNICOM” service will be provided on 127.3. This service will provide information on air display activity, parking and other information as required. Note that this is not a control service and a clearance to taxi, takeoff and land will NOT be given.

UNICOM operating hours:

Friday 26 August	1200 – 1700,
Saturday 27 August	0800 – 1720,
Sunday 28 August	0800 – 1700.

6. Air display practice will occur 1200 -1700 on Friday 26 August. Pilots should plan to arrive before this period, however aircraft arriving during the practice period may be requested to hold at 10 nm until the airspace is cleared for the arrival.
7. Please plan not to arrive or depart during the following air display periods:  
Saturday 27 August, 1150 -1400, 1510 -1720  
Sunday 28 August, 1000 –1200, 1300 - 1520
8. Light sport and general aviation parking areas are provided to the western and eastern areas of the main parking areas in front of the club houses. After landing “WATTS UNICOM” will instruct the arriving aircraft to taxi to the allocated area where a marshaller will continue to guide the aircraft to the specific parking lot.
9. The general public will not be allowed to walk among visiting aircraft.
10. A donation fee of \$5.00 per person will be requested from aircraft pilots and passengers.
11. Camping is only permitted in the allocated camping areas and normal fees will apply.
12. AVGAS is available at the airfield and can be paid by credit card.
